### Classes

If you're interested in classes but can't attend due to a schedule conflict, please let us know: The age ranges documented below are only guidelines, so it may be possible to enroll a student into another division's class, depending on exact age, height, focus ability, and the target classes demographics. It is also possible that additional classes will be added, based on demand.

Note that the Wednesday class is not open to beginners, and that six and seven year-olds will be evaluated throughout the first month of instruction to determine whether they are able to focus on fencing in a group environment without becoming overly tired or bored.

### Practices

After a couple of months of instruction, some students will be approved to attend Open Practices. These are entirely optional, and entirely free. These practices are attended by LSA students from all classes, members of the MSU Fencing Club, former private and collegiate students, and on occasion, visitors from other clubs and universities. Open Practice is held Mondays, 7:00p-9:00p (and sometimes later). It is possible that a second open practice will be added in Spring, 2009, based on demand.
